

The Ultimate Quilt Hanger

Mounting Instructions

Items you will need:

Hammer

Pencil

Tape Measure (optional)

Drill with 5/16" bit (optional)

#2 Phillips Screwdriver

Bubble Level

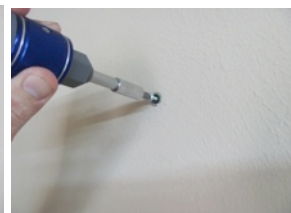
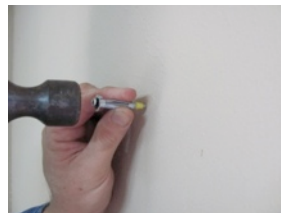
Painters Tape (optional)

Steps for Installation

1. Attach a hanging sleeve to your quilt by pinning or sewing the sleeve so that the top of the sleeve is aligned with the binding.



2. Spread the quilt hanger to the width you need for your sized quilt. A small piece of tape placed where both pieces join can help you maintain your width while you continue the installation. Note: It is not recommended to have less than 4" of overlap between the two pieces of your hanger.
3. Measure down from the ceiling and mark your first hole, hold up the quilt hanger and bubble level lined up with the first hole and level, then mark your second hole.



4. Gently hammer in the drywall anchors or drill a 5/16" sized hole and insert the drywall anchors. Carefully tighten the screw to lock the anchor in place, then remove the screws and set aside. **Note:** Do not use a powered drill or screwdriver for this step.
5. Slip the quilt hanger into the sleeve with the flat side facing the wall side of the quilt. Raise the quilt and hanger into position and attach it to the wall with the anchor screws.
6. Work from the middle of your quilt to each side smoothing out any wrinkles in your quilt.

Congratulations your quilt has been transformed into a hanging art piece.
